Moreover, our dedicated staff actively participates in community events such as fairs, volunteer/employment fairs, health and wellness expos, business expos, and conferences to disseminate information about domestic violence, agency services, and community resources.

Education and Prevention Impact in 2023

SVS is proud to report a significant impact in 2023 through its education and prevention initiatives:

- 240 total education and prevention events, reaching 5,305 individuals.
- 92 Teen Dating Violence Presentations with 2,552 attendees.
- 14 General Domestic Violence Presentations with 242 individuals.
- 11 Financial Empowerment Presentations with 160 attendees.
